Edinburgh Academy Junior School, Arboretum Road

- 1. From Leith, Newhaven and Trinity join QuietRoute (QR) 14 or 15 then onto QuietRoute 11. Exit at Granton Road (cyclists who aren't confident using the road should dismount at this point) and head towards Ferry Road. At Ferry Road, turn right and cross over at the controlled crossing continue toward Goldenacre and take the first left. The venue entrance is around 240m ahead on Arboretum Road.
- 2. From Portobello and Musselburgh, take QR 10 and then join QR 11. Exit at Granton Road (cyclists who aren't confident using the road should dismount at this point) and head towards Ferry Road. At Ferry Road, turn right and cross over at the controlled crossing continue toward Goldenacre
- 3. From Meadowbank, Lochend and Hillside join QR 20 and once you reach Arboretum Road, turn right. The venue is around 220m ahead on the right-hand side of the road.
- 4. From Liberton, Newington, The Grange and Marchmont, join QR6 to Forest Road. Cyclist should follow National Cycle Network (NCN) route 75 to 'Warriston Crossroad'. Exit to QR20 and then exit at Arboretum Road. The venue is around 220m ahead on the right-hand side of the road.
- 5. From Balerno, Currie, Colinton Craiglockhart and Morningside follow the route for QR 75 to Warriston Crossroad. Exit onto QR20 and then exit at Arboretum Road. The venue is around 220m ahead on the right-hand side of the road.
- 6. From Newbridge, Ingliston, South Gyle and Corstorphine follow QR 9 to Murrayfield Stadium when you should join QR 8 to Roseburn. At Roseburn Join QR 11 to 'Drylaw Crossroads'. At this point turn right onto QR 20 until you reach Aboretum Road. The venue is around 220m ahead on the right-hand side of the road.
- 7. From Queensferry, Cramond Bridge and Silverknowes follow QR 76 route to 'Drylaw Crossroads'. At this point join QR20 until you reach Aboretum Road. The venue is around 220m ahead on the right-hand side of the road.
- 8. From Cramond, Granton and Pilton follow QR 12 to Ferry Road. The join QR20 until you reach Aboretum Road. The venue is around 220m ahead on the right-hand side of the road.
