

## Edinburgh Park, Lochside Way

- 1. From Musselburgh, Duddingston, Newington and city centre join NCN 76 towards Queensferry. At Murrayfield join Quiet Route (QR) 8 towards Edinburgh Park. Exit at Lochside Court and head in the direction of the Edinburgh Park tram stop for 350m. At Lochside Way turn left – the venue is 50m ahead on the left-hand side.
- 2. From Murrayfield, Carrick Knowe, Morningside, Saughton and Broomhouse join QR 8 towards Edinburgh Park. Exit at Lochside Court and head in the direction of the Edinburgh Park tram stop for 350m. At Lochside Way turn left – the venue is 50m ahead on the left-hand side.
- 3. From Morningside, Craiglockart and Wester Hailes join NCN 754 towards Ratho. Leave the network at Cutlins Road (less confident cyclists should dismount at this point). Carry on along Cutlins road and cross Bankhead Drive at the controlled crossing. Pass over the bridge at Edinburgh Park station. With the Premier Inn on your left-hand side follow Lochside Ct for around 350m to Lochside Way. Turn left onto Lochside Way – the venue is 50m ahead on the left-hand side.
- 5. From Leith, Newhaven, Trinity, Pilton, Granton and Drylaw Join QR 11 to Murrayfield. At Murrayfield Join QR 8 towards Edinburgh Park. Exit at Lochside Court and head in the direction of the Edinburgh Park tram stop for 350m. At Lochside Way turn left – the venue is 50m ahead on the left-hand side.
- 6. From Gilmerton, Liberton and Cameron Toll join Spaces for people schemes on Gilmerton Road to the junction of Liberton and Lady Road. Turn onto Lady Road and follow QR 6 to Quartermile. At Quartermile join NCN 76 to Roseburn. Leave NCN 76 and join QR 8 to Edinburgh Park. Exit at Lochside Court and head in the direction of the Edinburgh Park tram stop for 350m. At Lochside Way turn left – the venue is 50m ahead on the left-hand side.
